RESOLUTION DECLARING OFFICIAL INTENT TO REIMBURSE EXPENDITURES FROM PROCEEDS OF BORROWING

WHEREAS, the Village of Elk Mound, Dunn County, Wisconsin ("the Municipality") plans to undertake work on the construction of a new water reservoir, water main to connect the reservoir to the existing system, and a large watermain loop (collectively, "the Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Municipality expects to finance the Project on a long-term basis with financial assistance from Wisconsin's Safe Drinking Water Loan Program and Clean Water Fund Program, which require issuance of tax-exempt bonds (the "Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, because the Bonds will not be issued prior to commencement of the project, the Municipality must provide interim financing to cover costs of the Project incurred prior to receipt of the proceeds of the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary, desirable, and in the best interests of the Municipality to advance moneys from its funds on hand on an interim basis to pay the costs of the Project until the Bonds are issued.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the Municipality, that:

<u>Section 1. Expenditure of Funds</u>. The Municipality shall make expenditures as needed from its funds on hand to pay the costs of the Project until Bond proceeds become available.

<u>Section 2. Declaration of Official Intent</u>. The Municipality hereby officially declares its intent under Treas. Regs. Section 1.150-2 to reimburse said expenditures with proceeds of the Bonds, the total principal amount of which is not expected to exceed \$2,500,000.

<u>Section 3. Unavailability of Long-Term Funds.</u> No funds for payment of the Project from sources other than the Bonds are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long term basis, or otherwise set aside by the Municipality pursuant to its budget or financial policies.

<u>Section 4. Public Availability of Official Intent Resolution.</u> This Resolution shall be made available for public inspection at the Village of Elk Mound's office within 30 days after its approval in compliance with applicable State law governing the availability of records of official acts including Subchapter II of Chapter 19, and shall remain available for public inspection until the Bonds are issued.

<u>Section 5. Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption and approval.
